In October 2007, Bristol Environmental Remediation was awarded a five-year, \$15 million contract with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to remediate leaking underground storage tanks (LUSTs) in Indian Country throughout the United States. Many of our staff had been involved in the work previously through sister subsidiary Bristol Environmental & Engineering Services LLC, which held the previous EPA LUST contract from October 2001 through September 2007.

The work under the current contract includes evaluation of LUST-eligible sites, site assessment/site characterization, remediation, and other technical support to the EPA. As of December 2007, BERS was operating one remediation system, designing several others, and actively conducting site assessments/site characterizations at many sites. Bristol has conducted work for EPA Regions 2, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10.

We have performed other remedial action projects for the US DOT (FAA) and the US Army Corps of Engineers involving identification and removal of hazardous wastes such as dioxin- and PCB- contaminated soil from remote Alaska sites, including Hoonah and Cape Yakataga.
